



QENSIU Respiratory Care Bundle Checklist



The respiratory care bundle should be put in place and the checklist completed for all patients admitted to Edenhall with High Spinal Cord Injuries (HSCI), for at least the first 7 days of admission. After this time, a medical decision should be made on which treatments to continue. Completing this checklist will help us audit the effectiveness of the respiratory bundle in lowering the incidence of intubation, particularly in extremis.

HSCI includes cervical injuries (ASIA A,B and C) and high thoracic injuries (T1 or T2). Multi-morbid patients may also benefit.
Please make sure all aerosol generating procedure are performed in keeping with GGC guidelines.
